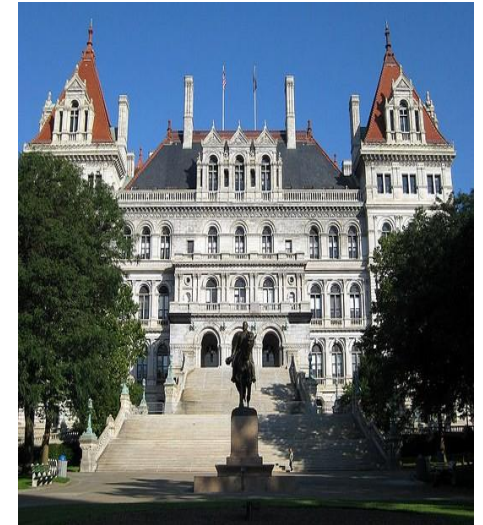
### Travel Information
